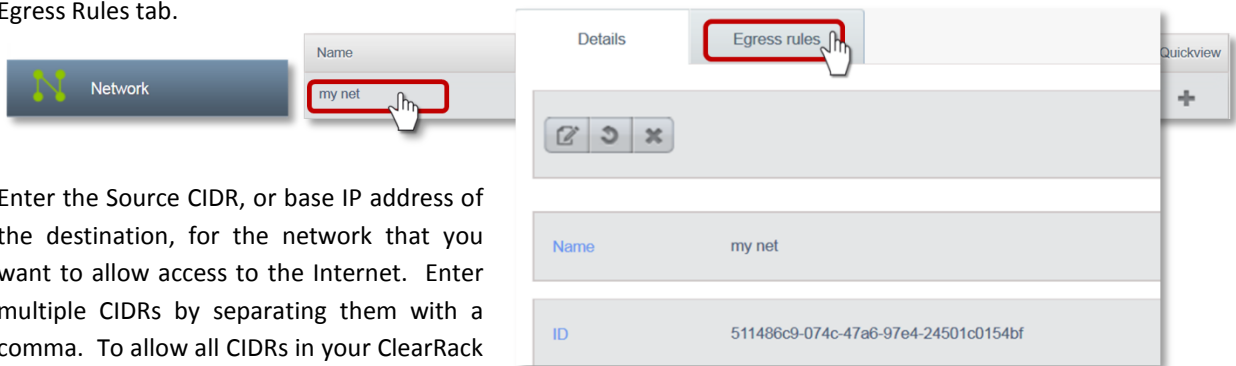


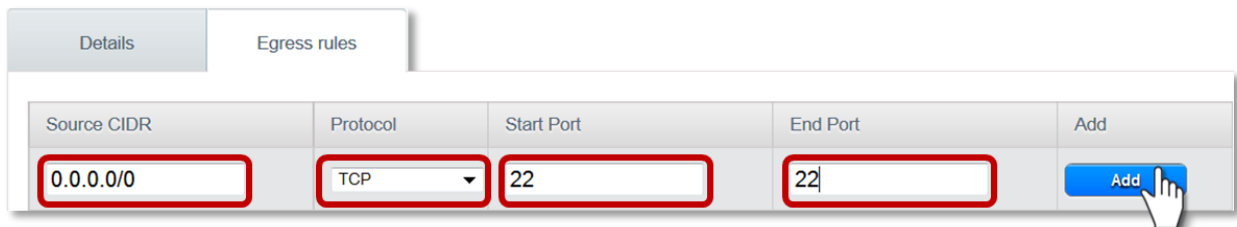
## Creating an Egress Rule

For the sake of protecting your data, ClearRack instances are initially created with outbound traffic prohibited as the default case. In order to unblock the egress of data and allow traffic to be transmitted from your cloud server, you must create an egress rule.

To create an Egress Rule, first log on to your ClearRack portal and, from your dashboard menu, click on the Network tab, and then on the network created for your instance. Then, on the window that pops up, click on the Egress Rules tab.



Enter the Source CIDR, or base IP address of the destination, for the network that you want to allow access to the Internet. Enter multiple CIDRs by separating them with a comma. To allow all CIDRs in your ClearRack networks, enter 0.0.0.0/0. Select the Protocol you want to use, Enter your Start Port and End Port, and then click on the Add button.



Your new Egress Rule is then created and will appear on your Egress Rule list.
